AUTHORIZED USE OF SCHOOL-OWNED MATERIALS

School equipment may be loaned to community groups for educational, civic, or charitable purposes when:

- 1. The group borrowing the equipment agrees to accept the responsibility for repairing or replacing any equipment damaged or lost while in its possession.
- 2. The equipment is not unusually expensive and subject to easy damage.
- 3. The equipment is in good condition.
- 4. The group will provide a competent operator for any machine borrowed.
- 5. Outside use of the equipment will not interfere with the school program.
- 6. The tools of the shop, machines, record players, projectors, etc. may only be used while under the supervision of a teacher.

Any student or other individual borrowing school equipment must sign an official receipt. A deposit may be required as determined by the Superintendent.
