FOOD SERVICES MANAGEMENT

The district shall operate a school lunch program in the school, which shall be under the overall supervision of the head cook.

The head cook shall cooperate with the superintendent in matters essential to the proper functioning of the food service program. The responsibility for control of students using the school cafeteria shall rest with any faculty member or cook as necessary.

Food services shall include hot lunches through participation in the National School Lunch Program.

The Board shall approve the prices set for meals and the price of milk.

As required for participation in the National School Lunch Program, the Board agrees to the following regulations:

- 1. That the food service program be operated on a nonprofit basis.
- 2. That a "Type A" lunch be made available for students to meet at least one-third of their daily food requirements.
- 3. That free and reduced-price lunches be provided students who cannot afford to pay the price of the "Type A" lunch.

Students shall be permitted to bring their lunches from home.
