## STUDENT FUND-RAISING ACTIVITIES

All fund-raising activities must be approved by the sponsor, student council, and administration.
Number of fund-raising activities per year,

1. $6^{\text {th }}, 7^{\text {th }}$ and $8^{\text {th }}$ grades - one separate money-making activity
2. $9^{\text {th }}$ and $10^{\text {th }}$ grades - one money-making activity
3. 11th grade - share in concessions for games. Two other money-making activities are allowed
4. $12^{\text {th }}$ grade - senior play plus two other money-making activities are allowed
5. Other high school clubs - one money-making activity. Style show, parent-student banquet, and official FFA and activities may be held as extras.
6. Elementary students limited to one charitable event per year. $\left(\mathrm{K}-8^{\text {th }}\right)$.

There will be some overall activities such as magazine sales, carnivals, athletic and scholarship banquets, etc. which will not be counted in the above requirements, but shall be one per year.

## DUES:

Classes and clubs may assess dues upon the majority vote of the group. Dues for $7^{\text {th }}$ and $8^{\text {th }}$ grades shall not exceed $\$ 1.00$ per year and $9^{\text {th }}$ and $10^{\text {th }}$ grades not over $\$ 1.50$ per year. $11^{\text {th }}$ and $12^{\text {th }}$ grades shall not assess dues higher than $\$ 5.00$ without permission of the sponsor and administration.
