Senior Trip

The following regulations have been adopted by the Board of Education for conduct on the senior trip.

- 1. The sponsors will be in complete charge at all times and no deviation from their direction will be allowed.
- 2. A respectable form of dress will be worn at all times
- 3. Respect will be shown at all times by all individuals.
- 4. There should be no smoking or drinking by students on the trip.
- 5. All activities will be directed by the sponsors and will be arranged so sponsors are with each group activity as far as possible. Curfews, lights-out, and other rules may be enforced as necessary.
- 6. Absolutely no action which will result in a poor reputation for the school will be tolerated. Rowdiness, vulgarity, poor manners are considered violations of this regulation.

It is understood by all concerned that infractions of these regulations may be considered sufficient reason to terminate that individual's trip, at the discretion of the sponsors. The parent will be responsible for transporting the student home at the parent's expense.

Any student going on a senior trip will comply with all regulations specified by the class sponsor, the administration, and the Board of Education.

The decision whether any student has earned or forfeited the privilege of participating in the senior trip will be left to the administration of the school.

All school policies and rules will apply.
