# Superintendent Report:

A small vehicle, 12 passenger Transport – 3 rows of 4 seats. Used price begins at \$33,000.00, New price \$48,000.00 government discount is for a new vehicle only of \$6,100.00. The white color they would have in a couple of weeks. Do we need 2 of these vehicles? It would be fiscally responsible to get one vehicle. The BUCaneers program couldn't happen on Wednesday due to not enough vehicles, 3 was on a route and 5 has a recall to get repairs. Coach bus has a secondary heating unit issue, copper tubing. Bus was moved to Transwest for repairs. Could get a 12 passenger or another 14 passenger bus. The suburban is getting older and the Escape has 79,000. Miles. Who/what schools have these Transport vehicles? Idalia, Limon and Liberty. How are they on dirt roads?

Access testing was completed today. Elementary was 2 weeks ago and sent off. Classes for next year options: Pre-Algebra class. Meeting with high school staff every Tuesday morning. NWEA data to support growth – how much algebra to fill this year? Students were not able to take a pre-algebra class-some kids aren't ready to move on to another math, this would help them before they go to a higher math. They need to cover enough chapters to be able to move to another math. Beginning planning class schedules to be prepared, kids that can go on to a higher math class should move on, maybe a post exam to be sure they are ready to move on. like 40-hour week, more time could enrollments- 2019/2020 through 2020/2023: 1 preschool, combined classes, who moves or stays. Preschool update: Fire inspection done & director, great. There are responses to the work that needs to be completed for a final approval.
